Choir crosses: Larry Hoover has ordered additional crosses which are similar to the ones currently used.

Choir seating: The keyboard will be moved to the Parish House creating a practice room. Folding chairs will supplement pew seating for the choir.

Choir rehearsals: Ash Wednesday choir rehearsals: 6:45 PM for the anthem to be sung at the Service and a short rehearsal after Service instead of the normal Thursday rehearsal. (Other rehearsals for the following 5 weeks will be on Thursday, as normal.)

Parish House piano: Edie will check on the feasibility and cost of needed repairs.

ELW: New hymnals were dedicated on Feb. 4. The new 1st setting will be introduced to the congregation during the five mid-week Lenten services. CDs of the music will be available for worshipers to take home and worship booklets will contain the new music to aid the congregation. Sunday morning worship during Lent will feature the old setting #3, which is the new setting #5.

Pastor Mathews walked the team through setting 1, pointing out how ELW differs from hymnals we have used in the past. ELW is a worship resource with many components which can be used in a variety of ways allowing congregations to customize their worship experiences.
