Team Meeting: October 3, 2006

Dick provided an overview of the Adult Forum topic: The Acts of the Apostles, which is being reviewed the first of each month and the importance of continuing to serve the Lord as this is a great time of growth in the church.

A copy of the minutes of the last meeting and a rough draft of the charter were provided and reviewed. It was determined that no changes or amendments would be made to the charter without Pastor Mathews or Bengt Berg.

The subcommittees were identified as follows:

Sunday Church School-covering Sunday school, adult morning class, future senior high school class and any other potential classes. Meetings are held for Sunday school staff every other month with an agenda of needs and anticipated events.

Vacation Bible School-meetings are held as needed for the planning and implementation of Vacation Bible School.

Confirmation Studies- Pastor Mathews provides instruction to 7th and 8th grade students. This year Janice Huylo is including confirmation aspects in her Sunday school class. Connie McDonnell expressed an interest in assisting Pastor Mathews in any capacity. Discussion was had regarding intertwining Confirmation with Youth Group and all aspects of the church including community service.

Adult weekday Bible Study- If there is an interest in weekly bible study and someone who may be interested in leading class.

Youth Ministry- Currently in process of search for Youth Director.

Trinity Lutheran Pre-school-Needs are addressed annually regarding salary, budget, enrollment.

The following was identified as a Task Force:

Weekend Parish Retreat- If there were to be a retreat at Bear Creek Camp, it would need only to be overseen by a task force, as it would not be an ongoing situation, but one that would be planned and held.
