Sunday Church School Sub-Committee Meeting: Sunday, June 24, 2007

Present: Pastor Mathews, Kathy Mathews, Marci McDermott, Dee Smith, Dick Yost, Mike Krahlng, Heather Klien.

The meeting opened at 11:00 AM with a prayer from Mike Krahlng.

The minutes of the last meeting were not discussed.

Heather Klien handed out an outline of questions to be answered pertaining to the possible new Sunday school curriculum "Akaloo." She informed everyone that there was ample space to record the team's decisions regarding Ackaloo.

Decisions made regarding Akaloo are as follows:

1. Akaloo will be the new Sunday school curriculum for the 2007/2008 school year.
2. The curriculum will become effective by mid July.
3. Pastor Mathews will contact Akaloo to initiate service.
4. Pastor will handle setting up the computer system for teachers, members, and staff in the office across from Carole Hamersly at the parish house.
5. Pastor will make the necessary contacts to get a broadband connection for the church.
6. Pastor Mathews and Heather Klien will set up the individual accounts for church members.
7. An Education Ministry Team meeting and Sunday School Teacher Ackaloo training session will be conducted on Sunday, July 29, 2007. We hope to tie up any loose ends and answer any questions concerning Akaloo at this meeting.

Pastor Mathews suggested that August 26 be the set date for the beginning of 2007/2008 Sunday school year teacher's meeting.

The first day of Sunday school is September 9, 2007.

Heather Klien reminded everyone that she is still looking for a Sunday school teacher for 1st and 2nd grade. Julie Fisher, Sara Juers, and Sean Juers were all mentioned as possible candidates. Heather said she would contact them and see if they are interested in serving.

Providing snacks for Sunday school classing was mentioned. Mike Krahlng suggested posting a sign up sheet to see if the parish would sponsor the weekly snack. Further information needs to be attained before any decision can be made regarding snacks for Sunday school.
